## Proposals

- i) Often abbreviated to CEP, The Centre for Environmental Policy is based in what was Weeks Hall. There is something a bit interdisciplinary about them, but organisationally they are firmly within the 'RCS'. They were invented about 20 years ago and have always been within RCS/FoNS. They are a post-graduate only department (which means they have no cause to award the ARCS).

The Executive ask that the AGM ratify the following change to our rules in order to include them within the RCSA's definition of the RCS....

*2. The Royal College of Science, hereinafter called "the RCS", shall be defined as being the current departments of Biochemistry, Biology, CEP (The Centre for Environmental Policy), Chemistry, Mathematics and Physics at the University plus any departments formerly described as part of the RCS (that awarded the ARCS Diploma) for such time as they were thus described.*

- ii) The Executive proposes no amendments to the Membership & Life Membership Fees. So they remain:

Annual Membership	£10
Life Membership	£200 or 10 x annual instalment of £25
Life Membership - aged 65 or over	£70
Student Membership	Free until 31 December of the year following graduation
